Council paused to review changes to page 9 & 10 of exhibit A. Discussion followed. Page 9 was adjusted to remove day of week for standard residential garbage service to avoid confusion, as service is provided to the majority of the city on Tuesdays, and a smaller portion on Wednesdays.

Dan Hyer moved to approve, as adjusted. Ryan Schnuerle seconded. Roll call vote was requested. The motion was approved with Ryan Schnuerle for the motion, Rob Fisher for the motion, Rachel Brobeck for the motion, and Dan Hyer for the motion.

Ryan Schnuerle moved to approve. Dan Hyer seconded. The motion received unanimous approval.

5.4 <u>Update regarding Development Fee Pass-Through to Caldwell Rural Fire Protection</u> <u>District.</u>

Caldwell Rural Fire Protection District (CRFPD) Administrator Mark Wendelsdorf reported that the State Legislature has made changes that necessitate changes in the documentation 28 October 2024 City Council Meeting Minutes, p. 2 of 5 with the city. CRFPD is also pursuing an update to the capital improvement plan. Mark described the process for implementing a CRFPD development impact fee advisory committee, and updating all partnering agency documentation. City Attorney Paul Fitzer explained that the statutes do not allow fire departments to do development impact fees directly, but can through partnership with cities and Counties. The CRFPD's attorney has done these agreements before, and Paul is comfortable with the documentation. Discussion continued.
